SUBJECT: Urgent Call for Local Empowerment, Employment Equity, and Legal

Compliance at N4 Gateway

To the Esteemed Directors and Senior Management of N4 Gateway,

On behalf of the people of **Mamelodi and Nellmapius**, and with the full moral authority vested in us as community representatives, **Soil of Africa Community Organization** submits this memorandum not as a request, but as a **formal declaration of concern and action**—in defence of economic dignity, lawful conduct, and human equity.

We approach you with the resolve of a people who have long been denied their fair share in the prosperity rising around them.

Demands and Immediate Concerns

1. Employment of Local Citizens

We demand that a minimum of **45% of the workforce** within the N4 Gateway precinct be constituted by residents of **Mamelodi and Nellmapius**. This reflects a call for equity and local development—not a favour, but a rightful share.

2. Allegations of Undocumented Labour

It has come to our attention that **undocumented foreign nationals** may be employed within your facilities. If these allegations are untrue, we request **verified documentation** proving the legal employment status of all workers, in accordance with South African law.

3. Exclusion of Established Local Residents

The **informal settlement adjacent to N4 Gateway** predates your establishment. It is indefensible that none of its residents have benefited from the job opportunities that emerged on their doorstep. This must be rectified immediately.

4. Local Business Engagement

We insist that N4 Gateway actively **subcontract and engage local businesses** from Mamelodi and Nellmapius. Please provide a full list of such partnerships as evidence of your commitment to inclusive development.

5. Submission of Community CVs

On 28 July 2025, during our peaceful community demonstration, we will submit CVs of skilled and unemployed local residents. We demand that these candidates be given immediate and fair consideration for employment.



Legal Foundation for Our Demands

We stand not only on moral ground, but also on the legislative foundation of the Republic of South Africa:

- **Labour Relations Act** (**No. 66 of 1995**) Promotes fair labour practices and the right to employment.
- **Basic Conditions of Employment Act (No. 75 of 1997)** Guarantees decent working conditions for all.
- **Employment Equity Act (No. 55 of 1998)** Requires transformation and affirmative action in employment.
- **Immigration Act (No. 13 of 2002)** Forbids employment of individuals without legal documentation.
- Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act (No. 53 of 2003) Supports empowerment of local and black-owned businesses.
- Municipal Systems Act (No. 32 of 2000) Affirms community rights in local economic development.

Demand for Immediate Response

Acknowledgement of Receipt

We request a formal written response within 72 hours of receipt of this memorandum.

Failure to respond will result in daily picketing, sustained community mobilization, and escalation of action through all available legal and civic channels.

Let this serve as a **final and formal call for accountability, inclusion, and justice**. The time for inaction has passed. The people are awake.
